There is not enough time given for learners to look up the questions. They have to know them well before taking the exam or they will not pass. However, if a nurse only uses technology, this provides a poor patient experience and demonstrates poor bedside manner. Also, if only technology is used, body language and gestures are missed and the meaning can be misinterpreted. It is recommended that the nurse continue learning as much as possible using this course and software, then use technology to fill in the gap.
